The Marsh View Veterinary Clinic is pleased to offer comprehensive care for our small animal patients. We have two exam rooms with one room dedicated to large breed dogs and the other for small breed dogs and cats. The large breed exam room is equipped with a "state-of-the-art" hydraulic lift table with a built-in scale. Our clients are telling us how

much they enjoy their pets stepping onto and being lifted once they are on the table.

We also offer a Treatment Room which is similar to a triage unit at a hospital. Minor procedures which do not require surgery, such as dental work, suturing, and ear flushes are completed in this area. All surgical procedures are completed in our surgery center. By keeping these rooms separate, we ensure the surgery room remains as sterile as possible throughout each day.

Lastly, we are excited to offer a Pharmacy and a Lab. It is important to our staff that we meet all of your needs whenever your pet becomes ill. Although not all lab tests are completed on-site, we offer comprehensive blood work services.

Dr. Jeff Hookstead is State Certified as a CWD Tissue Collector -Obex and Retro Pharyngeal Lymph Nodes. Test results take approximately seven to fourteen days. We provide this service to Elk and Deer Herds throughout Columbia and Dodge County, as well as for any hunters who would like to have the deer they killed during hunting season tested.
